The Young European Arena of Research

The **Young European Arena of Research** is a competition for early-stage researchers who are doing research in the area of road transport. The competition will give the students an opportunity to showcase their work to experts within the field, both on the web and, for the finalists, at the Transport Research Arena conference in Slovenia in April 2008.

Students are asked to submit an abstract on-line under one of six pillars, which will then go on public display on the YEAR website. This collection of abstracts will showcase the breadth and range of Transportation research in Europe and is open for viewing by all those interested in the field. From these submissions 50 finalists will be invited to attend the TRA08 Conference in Ljubljana, Slovenia in April 2008, to display their work. Gold, Silver and Bronze winners for each of the 6 pillars will be announced at the conference, for up to 1,500 delegates to observe.

Any early-stage researcher who is registered full-time in a college or university, within the EU, EU Candidate Countries, Potential EU Candidate Countries and European Economic Area is eligible to apply.

Also a strong contribution towards travel and accommodation costs.

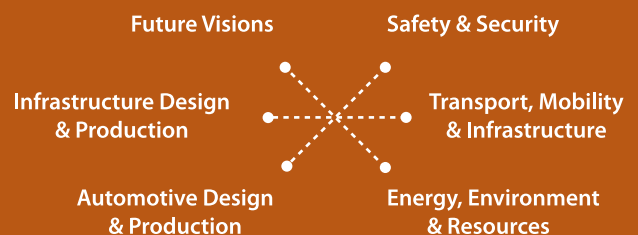
Gold, Silver and Bronze medals for the winning students in each pillar.
